About Brentwood Christian School

Established in 1963, Brentwood Christian School (BCS), a college preparatory school, and a ministry of Brentwood Oaks Church of Christ. BCS currently enrolls 642 students PK-12, 248 in EL3/4 through fifth grade, 149 in middle school, and 245 in high school. BCS welcomes students with a wide range of natural abilities from all religious, ethnic, and national origins who are seeking a solid Christian education. Minority enrollment is approximately 46%, with 14% Hispanic, 10% African American, 8% Asian, and 14% biracial. Located in a wooded area in northern part of Austin, BCS draws 50 percent of its students from Austin and 50 percent from surrounding towns.

Competition with a Higher Purpose

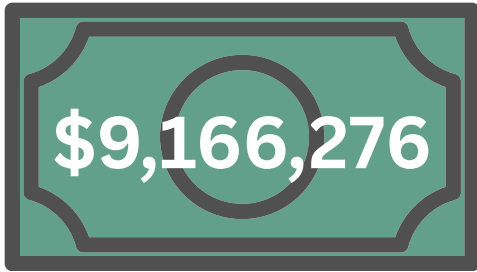
There are student athletes that grow their faith through fierce athletic competition. Sports teams at BCS are a positive space for spiritual and emotional growth.

- Effectively observe and evaluate faculty performance providing clear and actionable feedback, resources and support within the management protocol of BCS.
- Confer with faculty and parents to discuss educational activities, policies, student behavior and/or learning challenges.
- Promote and enact the BCS mission through preparations, interactions, words, and actions.
- Oversee and implement discipline that is within the framework of the BCS mission as well as the BCS Parent-Student Handbook.
- Participate in the preparation of the budget for the high school.
- Track, record and report key metrics as defined by the Office of Academic Advancement.
- Supervise and mentor High School faculty and staff.
- Support and promote the mission and core beliefs of BCS.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- Must have a master's degree in education or educational leadership and administration.
- Valid principal certification required.
- Must have 5+ years of classroom teaching experience and a minimum of 2 years of successful leadership experience in a secondary school. Christian school experience preferred.
- Must be an active member of a Church of Christ congregation.
